PRO Chester 29/15 covers the period from Michaelmas 29 Edward I 1301 to Michaelmas 30 Edward I 1302; Chester 29/16 that from Lady Day 33 Edward I 1305 to Michaelmas 33 Edward I 1305. Skeletal information for part of the intervening period is provided by PRO SC 6/771/5, the accounts of William de Melton, chamberlain of Chester, from the morrow of Michaelmas 31 Edward I (30 September 1303) to Michaelmas 32 Edward I (29 September 1304), which include details of the issues of the fines and amercements made at the county courts, and amercements and defaults in the eyre before the justice of Chester.

A translation of the accounts was published in 1910 in volume lix of *The Record Society for the Publication of Original Documents relating to Lancashire and Cheshire*, under the title *Accounts of The Chamberlains and other Officers of The County of Chester*, 1301–1360.
