Richard de Cawardin

The accounts of William de Melton, chamberlain of Chester, for 30 September 1301 to 29 September 1302 (SC6 771/1) include the receipt of £42 from Richard de Cawardin for the farm of the earl's avowries in Cheshire, by agreement with sir Richard de Massey when justice of Chester in 1300.

Richard de Cawardin appears in the county pleas for this period, but in no case that might be construed as relating to this office.
