

William Daniel

In April 1299 five separate actions were brought (by Robert Faber (Smith) of Aston, Geoffrey Starky, Walter son of Nicholas Cocus (Cook) of Dutton, Walter de Roughwood, and William son of Thomas de Moore-) in the county court against William de Hesketh, William Daniel, Alan de Churchley and Henry Bailey for having seized animals. At the next court the first of the plaintiffs, Robert Faber, withdrew. However, the second plaintiff, Geoffrey Starky stated that on Sunday 12 April 1299 at Bartington the defendants had taken a bullock and a heifer. None of the other three plaintiffs appeared.

Bartington was a township of Great Budworth parish, south of the Mersey, in Bucklow hundred, and in 'Haltonshire', the honour of Halton. The matter was adjourned court by court to December 1299, when Starky expanded his action by proceeding against the Constable, the earl of Lincoln, himself.

Ranulph son of Henry de Bartington sued Henry de Lacy, earl of Lincoln, William de Hesketh and William Daniel for disseisin of his free tenement in Bartington, in August 1300. The suit was adjourned successively until May 1302, when Ranulph failed to prosecute. Geoffrey Starky was one of his sureties.

At the same sitting Hugh Carpenter of Tarporley, indicted for having stolen fish from a stew (vivary), was released to the Constable's liberty.
