

Henry de Whitley

In April 1309 several separate plaintiffs came to court complaining that Henry de Whitley, as bailiff of the Constable, i.e. Henry de Lacy earl of Lincoln, had seized their cattle unjustly.

After several adjournments the matter came to a head in May 1310, when John Walton claimed that on Friday 27 June 1309 a heifer had been seized in the Fold in Grappenhall, and again 14 July 1309 after he had repledged it. This action was successfully overturned because of an error in the writ.

Hugh son of Brown claimed that 27 June 1309 a heifer had been seized in the Fold and driven to the earl of Lincoln's manor at Halton. To this it was argued that the earl's hundred court of Halton, held every fortnight, had jurisdiction over debts, contracts, trespasses and covenants in that hundred; that on 25 January 1309 one Peter del Birches had brought an action against Hugh in that court; Hugh had not appeared, and the animal had been seized as distraint, Grappenhall being within the jurisdiction of Halton hundred. Hugh answered that the earl of Lincoln had no hundred at Halton; that Grappenhall lay in the king's hundred of Bucklow.

William son of Richard claimed that on the same Friday in the same Fold a bullock of his had been seized. The answer was that William also had been sued by Peter del Birches in the same action, had not appeared, and had so been distrained. William argued, as before, that Grappenhall was outside the jurisdiction of the court of Halton.

Adam son of Hawisia had had a heifer taken at the same time, in the same circumstances; William son of Alan had had a bullock taken; William Boydel had had a horse taken; the pleas were the same as in Hugh son of Brown's case.

William de Thelwall had had a heifer taken on the same day at the same place, but his case differed in that at the same court at Halton 25 January 1309 he had been accused of brewing ale contrary to the assize; he had not attended. been amerced sixpence, for which the beast had been taken as distraint. His defence was the same; that Grappenhall was not within the jurisdiction of Halton. Alice who was wife of Nicholas Cocus (Cook) or Cosy claimed that a calf had been taken in the same way on the same basis.

These assize of ale cases differed from the others, as, it was asserted, such matters in Grappenhall had always lain within the jurisdiction of Bucklow hundred court.

The justice, Pagan de Tybotot, saw cases relating to the jurisdiction of the king's county and hundred courts as against various liberties — Halton fee, Macclesfield hundred, Vale Royal abbey, the city of Chester, the town of Wych Malbanc (Nantwich), and the summary decapitations carried out by the local serjeants.

This particular conundrum remained unresolved by Michaelmas 1310.
