

Bailiffs of Eddisbury hundred

Robert de Pulford, the parson of Coddington church, brought two writs against Robert son of Hugh de Pulford, Hugh son of Richard son of Avelina and Richard Key for having captured and then recaptured certain grazing animals seized from him on 6 September 1294 in a place in Buerton juxta Aldford called the Isle. Pulford said that the parson only had common of pasture in that place for eight plough oxen; the parson said that he had acquired the land in Buerton from one Richard son of Ralph together with the right to pasture on the common as many beasts as he liked at any time of the year. The case was repeatedly adjourned until October 1297 when an agreement was reached, and the parson paid the court 10 shillings for each writ as a licence to agree.
