Works done in the manors of Macclesfield and Overton

To master John Burgoillon, farmer of the manor of Macclesfield, for monies paid by him for repairing certain defects in the houses of the same manor in the 31st year, namely, for timber bought by him for mending the great hall of the said manor, nails bought for the said hall and the chamber, wages of the carpenters repairing the said hall in part, mending the roof of the great chamber, lime bought for whitewashing the walls of the hall, and the wages of the workmen whitewashing the same 6s 10¼d

To him for monies by him paid for repairing the enclosure of Macclesfield park broken in many places by the wind storm within the present year: and also in repairing certain defects in the haya del Coumbe of Macclesfield, namely, for the earl of Chester's share, as well by the hands of the parker of Macclesfield as of Adam Byran and Robert de Dounes, foresters of Macclesfeld in fee, and for making one machine of three truncis for taking wolves coming into the park and destroying the deer many times, as appears by the particulars of the same 22s 8½d

To him for monies paid by him for hay and oats for the stallion of Macclesfeld park, being sick from 1 February to 3 May, on which day he was put in the park, 91 days at 1½d a day, 11s 4½d. And for stabling (marescalcia) and shoeing the same stallion for the same time, and for one headstall (capistro) bought for the said stallion, 4d. Sum 11s 8½d

To master John Burgoillon, bailiff of the manor of Macclesfeld, for the money by him paid to divers carpenters and others felling and preparing (aptantibus) timber for the barrier (iarella) around the said manor and repairing the said barrier and the stable wall of the said manor, for their wages for eight days 6s 8d

To him for straw bought by him for the thatching of the said stable; carriage of the straw from divers places to the said manor, 11s 11d; wages of one thatcher thatching the said stable, and of divers men serving there and plastering the walls of the said stable; twigs bought for binding the said straw and boards bought for repairing the windows; and for nails bought as well for the boards as for the lattis, 9s. To him for monies paid to divers carpenters cutting down 27 ligna for repairing the bridge of the said manor and making planks of the same for the said bridge, and repairing the said bridge, for their wages and for carriage of the said timber, 22s 11d

To him for monies paid to John de Sutton forester for the wages of eight men repairing the lord's share of the haia del Coumbes, and of two men for one day working about the said fence, each taking 1½d a day.

To him for the wages of divers men mowing the grass in Macclesfeld park, spreading and lifting it and making hay thereof, and making it in three cocks for the lord's stud and deer being in the said park 4s 6½d

To him for monies paid by him for six millstones bought for the three mills at Macclesfeld, and for wages of divers workmen mending the ponds and weirs of the said mills 22s 9d Sum, 4l 19s ½d
