25 October 1295 Thomas de Tittenley sued Vernon, William de Praers, Ralph de Hanwell, Richard de Hanwell, Richard de Fowlshurst, Hugh de Fowlshurst, Richard de Alsacher, Hugh de Ridley, Richard Madin, Hamon de Stanthorne and Jordan le Harrower for having, on Thursday 9 June 1295, unharnessed six oxen and two afers from his plough at Thurstanhanes Field in Tittenley and driven them to Hurleston and kept them until they were recovered by the king's bailiff.

Ridley and Alsacher said that they were in no way involved. Vernon said that he held half a knight's fee in Tittenley, which he had purchased from Richard de Lostock and Agnes his wife: that he held the land by the service of providing a serjeant of the peace there, taking puture every three weeks from the tenants of eight messuages in Tittenley belonging to Thomas de Tittenley. Eight times puture had been demanded and refused, and therefore he had distrained on the plough team. Tittenley could not deny this, and was amerced 4s, and Vernon could have had the animals, but, for the present, did not press the matter.
