John and Hugh foster sons of John de Birtles demised to Isabella daughter of Richard de Fallibroome all that burgage in Macclesfield that was once of Robert Lovekin of Macclesfield, except the acre belonging to the burgage.

Richard de Fallibroome sold for 18s a plot of land 80 feet by 60 feet in Hurdsfield, with the grange built thereon, to St Werburgh's abbey, so that every morrow of St Andrew (1 December) prayers be said in Prestbury church for the souls of his mother and father (Richard).

Ricardus de Falingbrom dedit monachis Cestrie quamdam partem terre sue in Hirdelesfeld continentem octoginta pedes in longitudine et lx pedes in latitudine, cum grangia in ea edificata et omnibus in ea edificandis, cum libero exitu et introitu ex utraque parte grangie cum omnibus vehiculis, ita quod singulis annis in crastino sancti Andree apostoli dies anniuersarius pro animabus patris sui et matris et antecessorum et successorum suorum in ecclesia de Prestebur[ia] sollempniter celebretur.

Circa 1260, Richard Fallibrome sold a grange in Hurdsfield to Thomas Capenhurst, abbot of St. Werburg's, for eighteen shillings conditionally to a mass being said yearly on the

morrow of St. Andrew's anniversary for the repose of the souls of Richard Fallibrome, his father; his mother, his ancestors and successors, in the church of Prestbury. The attesting witnesses to this deed were Thomas de Orreby, Robert del Downes, Benedict de Coudray, Adam de Wright, William Pigot, Richard de Hurdsfield, Walter de Hurdsfield; Hugh, vicar of Prestbury; Adam, the preacher; Thomas de Bolton, Richard de Coudre; Richard de Orreby, chamberlain of Chester, and Peter Davenport.
