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Henry de Malo Passu

In June 1298, Henry son of Roger de Malo Passu sued John son of Thomas de Warwick for having disseised him of three messuages, 1½ saltpits and 6 acres of land in Malpas, Wigland, Over Foulwich and Nether Foulwich. The suit was renewed in December, now for three messuages, 1½ saltpits and 3 acres of land in Malpas, Wigland, Over Foulwich, Nether Foulwich and Bradley, Henry claiming that he had demised the property to Warwick while he (Henry) was under age. The jury agreed.
