In 1293 John son of Alexander Cracket sued William son of Simon the clerk for four messuages and 4 acres of land in Middlewich and Newton juxta Croxton. In January 1289 Elena daughter of Alexander Cracket brought a suit against William son of Thomas de Medio Wico for a saltpit in Middlewich (see Saline).
