Christiana who was wife of Adam le Sumner sued Stephen Dandy for a third part, as dower, of a third part of a messuage in Middlewich. Stephen called to warrant Henry de Stanthorne and Emma his wife, Emma having been wife of Richard Dodefyn. Emma says that she holds the third as dower of the inheritance of Thomas son of Adam le Sumnor, who was a minor.

Christiana who was wife of Adam le Sumner sued Felicia who was wife of Richard de Croxton for a third part, as dower, of two thirds of a messuage in Middlewich. Felicia called to warrant John son of John de Littlebury, whose body and part of his lands were in the ward of William son of Simon, and part of the lands in the ward of John son of Alexander Craket of Middlewich.

Christiana who was wife of Adam le Sumner demanded the return of two charters from Adam le Heuster of Congleton and Johanna his wife with which

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she had entrusted them. One was a deed of Ranulph de Acton enfeoffing Adam her late husband and herself of a messuage in Middlewich; the other was a similar deed about a messuage in Eccleshall. The defendants denied this, but said that Christiana's son William had deposited 13 charters with them and subsequently had them all back. The jury found in favour of Christiana.
