Mary daughter of William Alvane sued Nicholas Alvane of Wych Malbanc for a messuage in Wych Malbanc. She said that William Alvane her father had demised it to one Richard Alvane for a term of years now past, and it should revert to her. On the contrary, Nicholas said that his title derived from Margery de Wybunbury and Richard her son: the jury agreed.
