Claricia daughter of William le Irish, Hugh de Wollaston, Alicia his wife, Matilda and Matilda sisters of Alicia who was wife of William le Irish, sued the latter Alicia, Robert le Carter, Iorwerth Wallensis (Welsh) and William son of William de Honiley of a messuage (except 5 feet broad by 15 feet long) in Wych Malbanc. The latter Alicia, the actual tenant of the house, said that she was conjointly enfeoffed of it with William her late husband. The jury agreed.
