William Dunn of Wych Malbanc accused Roger son of Roger son of Thomas of Wych Malbanc, Richard Girdy and Reginald le Warrant of having disseised him of a messuage and 1 acre of land in Wych Malbanc. Roger said that Roger his father had enfeoffed him of that messuage but the other defendants had disseised him of it. The other defendants disclaimed any right in the property: the jury found that it belonged to Roger son of Roger.
