WALTER DE LANGTON

Walter de Langton was consecrated bishop of Coventry and Lichfield 22 December 1296 and died 16 November 1321 (*Fasti* i 549).

In 1297 Reginald de Grey and Matilda his wife called on Iorwerth son of Philip to acquit them of the customs and services that the bishop exacted from them in Chirton, Caldecote and Farndon, and of which Iorwerth was mesne between them.
